



Perfect Binding

For a classic, professional look on your magazine or catalog.



Some of the advantages of perfect binding are:

- **Versatility** — This binding method can accommodate many kinds of printed inserts, brochures, maps, CDs, etc. without additional operations. This can be an added source of revenue for publishers.
- **Printable spine** — By printing on the spine, your publication is easier to see on the shelf, in a stack, or in a file folder.
- **Durability** — We use hot melt glue, which is considered the strongest adhesive on the market. It has more lay-flat ability, superior flexibility, extreme temperature tolerance and solvent resistance. Hot melt glue is available if requested.
- **Visual appeal** — The squared spine gives a neat finish, books stack nicely too.
- **Options** — UV coating, foldouts, pocket covers, die cutting, foil stamping and embossing are just a few of the decoration and design options.

Signature Recognition Scanners scan every section of the publication to be sure they are collated in the right order. If the sensor finds an incorrect page, the entire system is stopped until the condition is corrected.

Another sensor measures the amount of adhesive applied to the spine of the book just prior to adhering the cover. This insures that every book has the right amount of glue.

Our perfect binder can accommodate publications as small as 4" x 5 3/8" and as large as 12" x 17". The thinnest publication that can be bound is 3/16" and the thickest is 2 3/8".
